

Hon. Christine M. Gravelle serves as Chief Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey and sits in the Trenton vicinage. She chairs the Bankruptcy Judges Advisory Group for the federal courts. She is a member of the National Conference of Bankruptcy Judges. She has written and participated in panel presentations and instructional videos for the Federal Judiciary Center.

Prior to joining the bench in 2013, Judge Gravelle was a partner at the law firm of Markowitz Gravelle, LLP in Lawrenceville, New Jersey, focusing on commercial litigation and bankruptcy. She served as President of the Mercer County Bar Association in 2011 after serving nine years as an officer and trustee for the Association. Judge Gravelle also served as a trustee of the Bankruptcy Section of the New Jersey State Bar Association. She served on the Board of Trustees of Central Jersey Legal Services as a member and officer. She received her J.D. from Suffolk University School of Law and her undergraduate degree from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst.
