David C. Smith is the Virginia Bankers Association Professor of Commerce at the University of Virginia and Associate Dean for Center Development & Research at the McIntire School of Commerce. Smith's areas of expertise include corporate valuation, corporate restructuring, leveraged credit, and distressed debt trading. He has presented his research at universities and conferences around the world and published in leading academic journals. He has also worked as a testifying expert on cases in state and federal courts related to company valuation, bankruptcy, corporate debt instruments, securities violations, and distressed debt trading.

Smith teaches courses on corporate finance, valuation, and distressed restructuring to undergraduates and MBA students. Prior to joining the University of Virginia, he was an economist in the International Finance Division of the Federal Reserve Board. Smith received his Ph.D. in finance from the Kelley School of Business at Indiana University and his B.S. in economics from the University of Delaware.
