David Nachman, from 2019 until April 2021, served as Counsel for Opioids and Impact Litigation in the New York Attorney General's Office. In addition to leading the Office's litigation against various other manufacturers and distributors of opioid products, David spearheaded the Office's work in investigating and pursuing New York's claims against Purdue and the Sacklers, before and after the bankruptcy filing, and co-chaired the ad hoc committee of nonconsenting state creditors in the Purdue bankruptcy. Previously, as Senior Enforcement Counsel in the Executive Division of the AG's Office, he led the multistate investigations into and litigations against Volkswagen, Bosch and Fiat Chrysler in connection with the "diesel cheat" conduct of these parties, as well as the trial team that prosecuted the Office's securities fraud case against Hank Greenberg, former CEO of AIG. David is a past chair of the New York City Bar Association's Committee on International Human Rights. He received a B.A. magna cum laude in philosophy and history from Brandeis University, and a J.D. summa cum laude from NYU Law School.
